Enclosed with this letter, submitted via email attachment, please find the Department of the Treasury's response to Judicial Watch, Inc.'s Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request, dated November 2, 2009.

As you will see, the Department is producing records totaling 109 pages. Some information has been excised in accordance with subsection (b)(2), (b)(4), (b)(5), and/or (b)(6) of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(2), (4), (5), and (6). Exemption 2 of the FOIA pertains to records related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency; Exemption 4 of the FOIA pertains to trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential; Exemption 5 of the FOIA pertains to certain inter- and intra-agency communications protected, for example, by the deliberative process privilege and/or the attorney-client privilege; and Exemption 6 of the FOIA pertains to information the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. To the extent duplicates were located, they were not processed.
