

Aulaqi is currently residing at 3331 Kaywood Drive, Falls Church, Virginia.

Recently, a discrepancy has arisen regarding Aulaqi's place of birth and, as a result, his U.S. citizen status may be in question along with the fact that he may have submitted fraudulent documents to U. S. Department of State.

INS, San Diego has determined that Aulaqi submitted a U. S. Information Agency, Associate Directorate for Educational and Cultural Affairs, Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor (J1) Status form, dated 6/2/1990, to INS. On this form Aulaqi states that he was born in Sana'a, Republic of Yemen.

Aulaqi has a U. S. passport, issued in 1993 and amended in 2000. Aulaqi stated on his passport application that he was born 4/21/1971 in Las Cruces, New Mexico.


