Dear Ms. Blankenberg:

This is the eighth interim response to the October 5, 2022, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) (2023-NPFO-00006).

For this production, DHS reviewed two hundred three (203) pages of which fifteen (15) pages were released in full, twenty-seven (27) pages were duplicative, sixty-six (66) pages were deemed non-responsive, and ninety-five (95) pages were released in part pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(6). I have considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing the record set and have applied the FOIA exemptions as required by the statute and the Attorney General's guidance.

The one hundred ten (110) pages provided are numbered DHS-001-03560-000962 to DHS-001-03560-0001071.

The first tweet is using falsified/photoshopped poll numbers to boost a particular candidate's write-in campaign. We don't have any results as of yet; ballots are not tabulated until after 8 p.m. election night.

[\(b\)\(6\)](https://twitter.com/(b)(6)) -- In the 2018 general election, 0.004% of the ballots were flagged as potentially fraudulent (142 out of the nearly 3.2M cast). Also, "if they see an 'R' they ditch it" is completely false. Washington voters do not register by party, and there's a detailed reconciliation election officials must report after every election that accounts for every ballot issued, received, counted, and rejected.
