Dear Mr. Farrell:

This responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request (attachment 1) submitted to the Department of Defense, Office of Freedom of Information (DoD OFOI) (06-F-0474), who located 22 responsive documents (117 pages) and referred the information to the U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM) for review and direct response to you. Your request/referral was assigned control number USSOCOM FOIA 2016-026.

DoD OFOI subject matter experts determined 27 responsive pages fall under their purview. Those 27 pages, Documents 3-18, are being withheld in their entirety pursuant to 5 U.S. Code (U.S.C.) § 552, Exemption (b)(1) because they are currently and properly classified in accordance with Executive Order (E.O.) 13526, Sections 1.4(a), 1.4(c), and 1.4(g). Other information is withheld pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6), which pertains to information the release of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of third parties.

Additionally, USSOCOM subject matter experts conducted a thorough review of the remaining 6 documents, 90 pages, which DoD OFOI originally identified as responsive to your request. We have determined Documents 1-2 (33 pages), Documents 19-20 and 22 (52 pages) contain full page or portions of information exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552, Exemption (b)(1), as the information is currently and properly classified in accordance with E.O. 13526, specifically, Sections 1.4(a), military plans, weapon systems, or operations; 1.4(c), intelligence activities (including covert actions), intelligence sources or methods, or Cryptology; 1.4(g), vulnerabilities or capabilities of systems, installations, projects, plans, or protection services relating to the national security; and Section 1.7(e), for compilation of items of information that are individually unclassified, but may be classified if the compiled information reveals an additional association or relationship. Additional segments are being withheld under (b)(6), for personal information that, if disclosed, would result in an unwarranted invasion of privacy; and (b)(7)(E), for information which would disclose investigative techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk

circumvention of the law. Furthermore, Document 21, 5 pages, consists of unclassified information that is releasable in its entirety.


We have considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing the records and applying exemptions under the FOIA. Copies of the redacted documents are being released to you are at attachments 2-8.

Your appeal must be postmarked within 90 calendar days of the date of this letter. Alternatively, you may email your appeal to osd.foia-appeal@mail.mil; include the words "FOIA Appeal" in the subject line, and please cite either case number DoD OFOI Ref: 06-F-0474 in USSOCOM FOIA 2016-026 in any correspondence.

Dear Sir/Madam:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552, Judicial Watch, Inc. hereby requests that the Office of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff (hereafter "CJCS") produce any and all agency records concerning, relating to, or reflecting the following subjects:

- 1) Able Danger
- 2) US intelligence, law enforcement and/or counterterrorism projects and/or programs utilizing data mining software/techniques to search open source records in the public domain.

**The time-frame for this request is October 1999 to present.**

For purpose of this request, the term "record" shall mean: (1) any written, printed, or typed material of any kind, including without limitation all correspondence, memoranda, notes, messages, letters, cards, telegrams, teletypes, facsimiles, papers, forms, records, telephone messages, diaries, schedules, calendars, chronological data, minutes, books, reports, charts, lists, ledgers, invoices, worksheets, receipts, returns, computer printouts, printed matter, prospectuses, statements, checks, statistics, surveys, affidavits, contracts, agreements, transcripts, magazine or newspaper articles, or press releases; (2) any electronically, magnetically, or mechanically stored

material of any kind, including without limitation all electronic mail or e-mail, meaning any electronically transmitted text or graphic communication created upon and transmitted or received by any computer or other electronic device, and all materials stored on compact disk, computer disk, diskette, hard drive, server, or tape; (3) any audio, aural, visual, or video records, recordings, or representations of any kind, including without limitation all cassette tapes, compact disks, digital video disks, microfiche, microfilm, motion pictures, pictures, photographs, or videotapes; (4) any graphic materials and data compilations from which information can be obtained; (5) any materials using other means of preserving thought or expression; and (6) any tangible things from which data or information can be obtained, processed, recorded, or transcribed. The term "record" also shall mean any drafts, alterations, amendments, changes, or modifications of or to any of the foregoing.

If any responsive record or portion thereof is claimed to be exempt from production under FOIA, please provide sufficient identifying information with respect to each allegedly exempt record or portion thereof to allow us to assess the propriety of the claimed exemption. *Vaughn v. Rosen*, 484 F.2d 820 (D.C. Cir. 1973), *cert. denied*, 415 U.S. 977 (1974). In addition, any reasonably segregable portion of a responsive record must be provided, after redaction of any allegedly exempt material. 5 U.S.C. § 552(b).

**Judicial Watch also hereby requests a waiver of both search and duplication fees pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(ii)(II) and 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(iii).**

Judicial Watch is entitled to a waiver of search fees under 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(ii)(II) because it is a member of the news media. Judicial Watch, Inc. regularly obtains information about the operations and activities of government through FOIA and other means, uses its editorial skills to turn this information into distinct works, and publishes and disseminates these works to the public. It intends to do likewise with the records it receives in response to this request.

As a member of the news media, Judicial Watch uses the following means, among others, to publish and disseminate its distinctive work to the public:

- (1) Judicial Watch maintains an Internet site, [www.JudicialWatch.org](http://www.JudicialWatch.org), where the public can review records obtained through FOIA and read editorial works prepared by Judicial Watch, Inc., including news releases, based on FOIA materials. This website is viewed by over 20,000 people per day on average, and on several occasions, has logged up to 1,000,000 visitors in a single day.

(2) Judicial Watch also publishes a monthly newsletter in which it publishes its own editorial works and presents, analyzes, and explains information it obtains through FOIA. Judicial Watch, Inc.'s newsletter is sent to approximately 140,000 individuals each month. The organization also utilizes an e-mail Infonet service that sends out updates of Judicial Watch's activities over the Internet to almost 14,00 persons.

(3) Judicial Watch also periodically publishes and disseminates its own distinct works in the form of books and reports. For example, in September 1998 Judicial Watch, Inc. published the *Interim Report on Crimes and Other Offenses Committed by President Bill Clinton Warranting His Impeachment and Removal from Elected Office*. This 145-page report was accompanied by nearly 4,000 pages of supporting documentation and was crafted, in part, from the raw materials obtained by Judicial Watch through FOIA requests, among other regular means. In August 1999, Judicial Watch published *Filegate Status Report*, which is 136 pages long and is supported by nearly 1000 pages of documentation. In March 2001, Judicial Watch, Inc. published *The Judicial Watch Florida Recount*, an independent, non-partisan analysis of the results of Florida's hotly contested 2000 Presidential election based upon an sampling of ballots reviewed by Judicial Watch pursuant to Florida's version of FOIA. In February 2002, Judicial Watch published *The Judicial Watch 2002 "State of the Union" Report, Bush Administration Ethics Enforcement: "A Failure of Leadership."* In September 2002, Judicial Watch, Inc. published *Fatal Neglect: The U.S. Government's Continuing Failure to Protect American Citizens from Terrorists*. Most recently on November 21, 2003, Judicial Watch produced *Analysis of GAO Testimony: US Postal Service – Clear Communication With Employees Needed Before Reopening of Brentwood Facility*. (GAO-04-2057T/October 23, 2003). Comptroller General of the United States David M. Walker, in a reply to Judicial Watch's *Analysis of GAO Testimony*, wrote on December 17, 2003, "We view Judicial Watch as an important accountability organization in Washington, D.C." On February 16, 2005 Judicial Watch was rated by the highly respected capitol newspaper *The Hill* as being one of the nation's top ten "watchdogs." Most recently, on June 29, 2005, Judicial Watch produced a special report *US Border Patrol Survey Analysis*, a report of an analysis of documents produced under FOIA.

Judicial Watch also publishes and disseminates its distinctive work by participating in public conferences and seminars, including its own "Ethics in Government" conferences held in Pasadena, California (1999), Washington, DC (2000), and Miami, FL (2001). Judicial Watch also works with other media organizations to publish and disseminate distinctive work to the public, and representatives of Judicial Watch appear frequently on nationally broadcast television and radio programs. Judicial Watch has been granted press credentials at a number of national conventions and other events.

Consequently, Judicial Watch qualifies for a waiver of search fees as a member of the news media. See *National Security Archive v. U.S. Department of Defense*, 880 F.2d 1381, 1387 (D.C. Cir. 1989). In fact, Judicial Watch has been recognized as a member of the news media in

other FOIA litigation. *See Judicial Watch, Inc. v. U.S. Department of Justice*, 133 F. Supp.2d 52 (D.D.C. 2000).

Judicial Watch also is entitled to a complete waiver of both search fees and duplication fees pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(iii). Under this provision, records:

shall be furnished without any charge or at a charge reduced below the fees established under clause (ii) if disclosure of the information is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of government and is not primarily in the commercial interest of the requester. 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(iii).

Judicial Watch is a 501(c)(3), not-for-profit, educational organization, and, by definition, it has no commercial purpose. Judicial Watch exists to educate the public about the operations and activities of government, as well as to increase public understanding about the importance of ethics and the rule of law in government. The particular records requested herein are sought as part of Judicial Watch ongoing efforts to monitor the operations and activities of the federal government and to educate the public about these operations and activities, and, in particular, as part of an investigation into the facts and circumstances surrounding Able Danger.

Courts applying the "public interest" fee waiver provision of FOIA typically take into account four factors in determining whether to grant a waiver: (1) whether the subject of the requested records concerns the operations or activities of government; (2) whether disclosure of the requested records is likely to contribute to an understanding of government operations or activities; (3) whether disclosure of the requested records will contribute to a "reasonably broad" audience and whether the requestor has the "ability and intention" to disseminate the information to the public; and (4) whether disclosure of the requested record will contribute "significantly" to the public understanding. *See D.C. Technical Assistance Org. v. HUD*, 85 F. Supp.2d 46, 48-49 (D.D.C. 2000); 28 C.F.R. § 16.11(k)(2)(i)-(iv). Request for "public interest" waivers are to be judged on a case-by-case basis." *Larson v. CIA*, 843 F.2d 1481, 1483 (D.C. Cir. 1988).

Without question, the subject-matter of the request concerns the operations and activities of government, namely open source data mining operations such as Able Danger and the assertion that 9/11 hijackers had been identified by intelligence agencies a year before the 9/11 attacks.

Disclosure of the requested records is likely to contribute to an understanding of government operations and activities and will appeal to a "reasonably broad" audience because the records relate directly to the facts and circumstances surrounding the Able Danger operation, and the terror attacks of 9/11.

Indeed, the taxpaying American public deserves full disclosure of the facts and circumstances surrounding the Able Danger operation, which has made international headlines in news reports and Congressional hearings. The public has the full right to disclosure of information regarding how the federal government went about using the information obtained by Able Danger for the protection of the American public before September 11, 2001. According to news reports and disclosures by members of Congress, the information identified by Able Danger could have stopped the activities of the 9/11 hijackers and their related terror cells.

Once Judicial Watch obtains the requested records, it intends to analyze them and disseminate the results of its analysis, as well as the records themselves, as a special written report. Judicial Watch will also educate the public via radio programs, Judicial Watch's website, and/or newsletter, among other outlets. It also will make the records available to other members of the media or researchers upon request. Judicial Watch has a proven ability to disseminate information obtained through FOIA to the public, as demonstrated by its long-standing and continuing public outreach efforts, including radio and television programs, website, newsletter, periodic published reports, public appearances, and other educational undertakings.

Finally, disclosure of the requested records will contribute significantly to the public's understanding because relatively little is known about "Able Danger" and the investigation methods cited. The records requested by Judicial Watch undoubtedly will shed additional light on this important matter.

Given these compelling circumstances, Judicial Watch is entitled to a public interest fee waiver of both search costs and duplication costs. Nonetheless, in the event our request for a waiver of search and/or duplication costs is denied, Judicial Watch is willing to pay up to \$350.00 in search and/or duplication costs. Judicial Watch requests that it be contacted before any such costs are incurred, in order to prioritize search and duplication efforts.

We look forward to receiving the requested documents and a waiver of both search and duplication costs within twenty (20) business days.

Laden of financially and militarily supporting an ethnic cleansing in Afghanistan in collaboration with Taliban. Arab countries in North Africa especially Algeria, Tunisia, Morocco, Libya, Egypt and almost all other Arab countries have been annoyed for the high profile of Osama bin Laden first in Pakistan and later in Afghanistan especially, when he publicly claims that he trains Arab fundamentalists to overthrow most of Arab regimes in the Middle East. Only recently, the US and British media accused bin Laden of involvement in drug trafficking. In this regard the London-based English daily The Observer wrote that Osama bin Laden is using heroin as a powerful new weapon in his war with the West.

It claims that bin Laden approached, through intermediaries, major opium and heroin dealers and big landowners in opium-growing districts of Afghanistan and offered to buy all the opium they grow (Jason Burke, The Observer, December 6, 1998.) The laboratories, made of stones, were 34 and not 200 as was claimed by the Anti-Narcotics Force chief in Peshawar. received the information about the arrival of this man and relevant sources reported that the amount of heroin he was carrying was 40 kilograms. Of course, the recovered amount weighed 24 kilograms. Although the recovered amount was the biggest so far, this is not the biggest smuggling incident. This drug smuggling has become a routine affair. This consignment was brought in a novel way. The heroin were packed in 118 beautiful packets of Lux soaps, similar to the soaps sent to the Middle Eastern countries. This brown colored heroin is sold in Europe and the United States at very high prices. Every 200 grams of this variety of heroin is sold in the black-market in London for 20,000 pounds. In fact, heroin is the major source of income for the Taleban government that has seized power in Afghanistan. Other major impediments to meaningful counternarcotics progress include inaction and lack of political will of the Taliban faction, which controls 96 per cent of AFGHANISTAN'S opium growing areas, as well as substantial drug trade involvement on the part of some local Taliban authorities. An estimated 95 percent of Afghanistan's opium poppy cultivation and most of Southwest Asia's MORPHINE base and HEROIN processing laboratories are located in territory controlled by the Taliban.

Moreover, they insist they cannot afford-politically-to crack down on farmers. "We are against poppy cultivation, narcotics production and drugs," says Abdul Hakeem Mujahid, the Taliban representative in the United States. "But we cannot fight our own people. They are the sole source of our authority." That's only a half-truth. The fuller version is that the Taliban also earns taxes directly not just from poppy farmers, but from HEROIN labs. Zuber, the addict who now lives in a Peshavar rehabilitation clinic, says that his lab packed MORPHINE base into bundles that were taxed at about \$ 55 per kilogram ( 2.2 pounds) by the Taliban. The daily tax revenue at that lab alone could amount to \$ 5,500 in peak season-and the facility was one of 20 or 25 in the vicinity. NEWSWEEK has also examined photographs of official tax receipts from the heroin labs. "Criminal elements, religious elements and official elements are all connected in the heroin trade like rice and honey," says a law-enforcement agent for a Western government who has done undercover work in AFGHANISTAN. Opium is traded at large bazaars in Afghanistan that are the treacherous domain of criminal syndicates. One of the more notorious is located in the town of Sangin, a three-hour drive west of the Taliban capital at Kandahar. "Sangin is known as a dangerous place," says Bernard Fzahi, head of the U.N. drug-agency office in Islamabad, who visited the market town in October. "It is known for people going in and not coming out." Of about 500 shopkeepers crowded along one main street and two or three footpaths off it, he says, almost half sell opium.

The 7.5 tons of MORPHINE base, which can be refined into an equivalent amount of pure HEROIN, is more than five times the 1.4 ton total of morphine base and heroin seized throughout the United States in 1992. A recent multi-ton seizure occurred January 7 near the Suez Canal when Turkish narcotics agents, aided by U.S. intelligence, seized a freighter headed for the southeastern Turkish port of Bodrum and found 2.7 tons of morphine base aboard. On December 15, agents were stymied when a Turkish freighter was scuttled that Turkish intelligence agents had observed being loaded with 170 bags of morphine base weighing 3.8 tons. During this period Turkish agents seized 1.3 tons of morphine base on two

## Principal questions

Too many employees within ABV Rock Group/(C)MC working within Saudi Arabia are very frustrated because they consider that certain responsible persons of the ABV Rock Group/(C)MC management act in a senseless and ruthless way

- 1 **WHY** have at least three of my legal advisors, before they accepted to represent me, told me that it was obvious that we should win the case and after having contacted ABV Rock Group/(C)MC not acted as if they represented me?  
**The first one:** An attorney at a lawfirm in Riyadh was my unofficial advisor during about three months. He told me that the behaviour of ABV Rock Group/(C)MC in connection with the discharge of me "It is the most rotten behaviour I ever have heard about. Not even the Arabs do like this! Sue them for breach of the all the articles!" (Referred to most of the listed articles of the Saudi Labour Law). We had thereafter a very good communication. After having announced that he represented me he answered neither my telephone calls nor my faxes. He is not any longer admitted in Saudi Arabia.  
**The second one:** The head legal representative in my union travelled from Stockholm to Gothenburg to visit me and my wife in order to show the importance of my case. He told us that the union "in this case"ll really should protect the employee. He also told me that he should ensure that the magazine of the union should warn members to enter into contracts of employment with ABV Rock Group. He also let me understand that my boss in Saudi, Mr Göran Öwesson, was a looser since he had been sacked from his former employer. This is neither relevant for my case nor ethical for a legal representative of a union! After having contacted ABV Rock Group/(C)MC he put forward issues which were completely incorrect and later used against me in the court by ABV Rock Group/(C)MC. My union wanted me to accept a shameless offer from ABV Rock Group/(C)MC which I didn't. Then my union formally jumped off.  
**The third one:** Based on the advise from a reputable lawfirm in Sweden I insisted on that we should argue according to the Saudi Labour Law. My third legal representative then told ABV Rock Group/(C)MC that I didn't accepted the Saudi Labour Law! He told me not to say anything in the District Court. In the District Court my legal advisor made no objections to ABV Rock Group/(C)MC legal advisor's false and irrelevant statements and hence we lost. Also in the Labour Court we lost due to the fact that he did not represented me in the way I wished.
- 2 **WHY** does it look like ABV Rock Group/(C)MC does not need to follow mandatory articles of applicable laws?
- 3 **WHY** does it look like the Swedish authorities so far have not taken necessary corrective actions with respect to my original key question, which was initiated by Price Waterhouse who terminated the co-operation with ABV Rock Group due to their unethical behaviour. **Shall the Swedish judicial system accept a cynical Arabic culture in which the laws are strictly used against certain individuals and companies but in reality are not followed by those who have the money and/or the suitable contacts?**

By this I want to say that I like challenges, a constructive and a creative thinking and believes in the "good organisation" in which everyone treats his customer as he wants to be treated by his supplier.
