This is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, originally received by the United States Secret Service (Secret Service) on August 12, 2024, for information pertaining to:

1. Any and all emails and text messages sent to and from members of the Vice Presidential Protective Detail regarding the break-in by Secret Service officials of the Four One Three Salon in Pittsfield, Massachusetts on July 27, 2024, as described in various news media, such as <https://nypost.com/2024/08/11/us-news/secretsservice1apologizes-to-salon-owner-over-break-in-bathroom-use-during-kamalaharris-event>;
2. Any and all emails and text messages sent to and from the Special Agent-in-Charge of the Secret Service field office in Boston, as well as Acting USSS Director Ronald Rowe, Assistant Director Michael Plati, Assistant Director Brian Lambert, and Assistant Director David Smith regarding the break-in of the Four One Three Salon; and
3. Copies of any and all complaints filed against the Secret Service by individuals or businesses impacted by Secret Service operations in connection with the July 27 Harris campaign fundraiser in Pittsfield, Massachusetts.

(Date Range for Record Search: From 7/24/2024 To 8/12/2024).

After a detailed review of all potentially responsive records, 62 pages were released and 0 pages were withheld in their entirety. After considering the "Foreseeable Harm" standard, outlined in Title 5 U.S.C § 552(a)(8)(A)(i) and Department of Justice guidance, exemptions under FOIA Statute Title 5 U.S.C. § 552, and/or the PA Statute Title 5 U.S.C. § 552a, have been applied where deemed appropriate.

Enclosed are the documents responsive to your request, as well as a document that explains the exemptions in more detail. Withheld information is pursuant to the exemptions marked below.

She and Lacy entered the Capitol through a broken window around 3:31 p.m., according to surveillance footage from inside the Capitol and Lindsey's videos. The FBI said the women left the building roughly five minutes later, because they were met by police in riot gear.

For the next two hours, authorities say Lindsey continued to record videos on her phone and was approached by a Secret Service officer at 5:25 p.m. near the Presidential Transition Office. The agent said that Lindsey was doing something suspicious with a metal pole, according to court records.

That's when the agent saw the sword attached to Lindsey's leg and found the other weapons during a search of her backpack, the affidavit said. Secret Service agents seized her weapons and Lindsey recorded a TikTok video to complain.

"I was just detained, and they confiscated my sh—," she said in the video.

In an interview with the FBI in March 2021, Lindsey described the objects in her backpack as "tools" and denied carrying any weapons into the Capitol on Jan. 6, according to the affidavit. She eventually admitted to having them in her backpack inside in a subsequent interview, the affidavit said.

Lindsey was arrested in Los Angeles on July 28 on suspicion of entering and remaining in a restricted building or grounds with a deadly or dangerous weapon; disorderly and disruptive conduct in a restricted building or grounds with a deadly or dangerous weapon and other charges.

According to court records, both women were scheduled to appear before a judge on Thursday in the District of Columbia.

Lacy was arrested the following day on suspicion of entering and remaining in a restricted building or grounds and other charges. Roughly 1,400 people have been charged with Capitol riot-related federal crimes since the insurrection.

An email to Lacy's attorney was not immediately answered. It's unclear whether Lindsey has any legal representation.

[MA] Pittsfield salon owner feels violated after a break-in during Harris' visit (Massachusetts - Spectrum News 1)

Vice President Kamala Harris visited Pittsfield on Saturday, July 27, 2024.

Owner of Four One Three Salon, Alicia Powers, says during the visit, people she doesn't know entered the business and used the bathroom without her permission.

Powers says she felt violated by the break-in and based on video from outside and inside the salon believes they are with and operating at the instruction of federal agents.

“Violated, disrespected and I’m just totally blown away that there wasn’t permission granted or even asked to go into the bathroom,” said Powers.

“Did say that they were supposed to ask for permission? They were not supposed to tape it without my permission and really apologized up and down and did offer to do anything they could, with paying the alarm bill, having the salon cleaned and just said that it’s not the way that Secret Service does things,” Powers said.

Spectrum News 1 reached out to the Secret Service for comment and spokesperson Melissa McKenzie sent us a statement, saying:

“The U.S. Secret Service works closely with our partners in the business community to carry out our protective and investigative missions. The Secret Service has since communicated with the affected business owner. We hold these relationships in the highest regard and our personnel would not enter, or instruct our partners to enter, a business without the owner’s permission.”

Powers said she appreciated the accountability and it’s all she wanted. She even noted the person she spoke with offered to come out and see the salon.

“He just offered to come out and see the salon and wanted to apologize face to face and just let me to know that this is not how they do things normally,” said Powers.

We also contacted Pittsfield Police, who said they were not involved in the incident.

[IL] Potential ‘retaliatory’ attacks at DNC a concern following Trump assassination attempt, federal assessment says (CNN)

US security officials are on alert for possible retaliatory attacks against Democrats following the attempted assassination of former President Donald Trump, according to a new intelligence report obtained by CNN.

The threat assessment — prepared jointly by the FBI, Department of Homeland Security, and other agencies, including local police in Illinois — outlines various potential security concerns surrounding the upcoming Democratic National Convention in Chicago.

“The FBI and DHS remain concerned about the potential for follow-on or retaliatory acts of violence following the 13 July 2024 assassination attempt on (Trump) particularly given that individuals in some online communities have threatened, encouraged, or referenced acts of violence in response to the attempted assassination,” the assessment says, noting agencies have not identified any specific and credible threats.

While the motive of the gunman who fired on Trump remains a mystery to investigators, the bulletin says “politically and socially divisive topics have prompted violence in the past,” and adds that some extremists “will view political and social tensions as an opportunity to use or promote violence to further their ideological goals.”

"Luckily, we have good relationships with other communities," he said of the items the city borrowed. That reduced expenses to paying city workers to fetch and return the items, and fuel for city trucks.

As for overtime: Morales said his departments needed extra help before, during and after the event, to ready the streets around the Colonial Theatre and then put them back to normal. "Falling on a Saturday and a Sunday, it was overtime and double time for some of the work," he said.

Between eight and 12 DPW workers were on different shifts through the weekend, and workers were excited to be involved, Morales said.

"I'm not speaking of political affiliations ... It's just that having the vice president visit is a significant event."

Berkshire County Sheriff Thomas Bowler's office said the department had 19 officers deployed on July 27 and incurred a little more than \$10,000 in overtime. That amount will not be charged to the city, VanBramer said.

According to Dawley, other agencies working with the Secret Service, state police and city agencies that day included the Hampden and Franklin sheriff's departments, County Ambulance, the Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency, the Berkshire County Special Response Team, most Berkshire County police departments, Berkshire Medical Center, "and whomever else I have not mentioned."

[MA] Secret Service apologizes after breaking into Massachusetts salon to use bathroom before Harris fundraiser (FOX News)

The U.S. Secret Service was forced to apologize to a Massachusetts salon owner after using her building's bathroom without permission ahead of a fundraiser for Vice President Kamala Harris last week.

The salon owner, Alicia Powers, says Secret Service agents put duct tape over her security cameras and broke into her building by picking the lock. They then allowed various people to use the salon's bathroom over a two-hour period.

Powers told Business Insider that she was aware she had to close her salon but was not informed about the Secret Service's other plans.

"They had a bunch of people in and out of here doing a couple of bomb sweeps again – totally understand what they have to do, due to the nature of the situation," Powers told Business Insider. "And at that point, my team felt like it was a little bit chaotic, and we just made the decision to close for Saturday."

Footage from the salon's front-door Ring security camera shows a Secret Service agent approaching the door with a roll of tape and observing the locked door and the camera. The agent then grabbed a nearby chair and stood on it to tape over the security camera.

"There were several people in and out for about an hour-and-a-half – just using my bathroom, the alarms going off, using my counter, with no permission," Powers told BI.

"And then when they were done using the bathroom for two hours, they left, and left my building completely unlocked, and did not take the tape off the camera," she added.

The Secret Service says it has been in contact with Powers following the incident. The business owner said she received an apology from the Secret Service's Boston office.

"The U.S. Secret Service works closely with our partners in the business community to carry out our protective and investigative missions. The Secret Service has since communicated with the affected business owner," USSS spokeswoman Melissa McKenzie told Fox News Digital. "We hold these relationships in the highest regard and our personnel would not enter, or instruct our partners to enter, a business without the owner's permission."

Powers told the outlet that an EMS worker later told her the Secret Service agent in charge of security that day "was telling people to come in and use the bathroom." The Secret Service told BI that its agents "would not" have used the building without permission, but they acknowledged that an agent had taped over the camera.

"Whoever was visiting, whether it was a celebrity or not, I probably would've opened the door and made them coffee and brought in donuts to make it a great afternoon for them," Powers told BI. "But they didn't even have the audacity to ask for permission. They just helped themselves."

The building's landlord, Brian Smith, says no one gave the Secret Service officers permission to use the building or even enter it.

"Me and my dad own the building, and I have a crazy eccentric guy that lives upstairs," Smith told BI. "And he didn't tell the Secret Service they could use it, and I didn't tell them, and my father didn't tell them, and they had no permission to go in there whatsoever."

Powers says a representative for the Secret Service's Boston field office called her to apologize after BI contacted the agency about the incident.

"He said to me everything that was done was done very wrong," Powers told the outlet. "They were not supposed to tape my camera without permission. They were not supposed to enter the building without permission."

[MA] Secret Service hints it wasn't behind salon break-in during Kamala Harris campaign event (FOX News)

The U.S. Secret Service has hinted it was not involved in the break-in of a hair salon during a Kamala Harris campaign event in Massachusetts late last month.

The allegations of Secret Service involvement arose after the salon's owner, Alicia Powers,

alleged that agents put duct tape over her security cameras and broke into her building by picking the lock.

Security camera footage shows an individual dressed like a Secret Service agent approaching the door with a roll of tape and observing the locked door and camera before grabbing a nearby chair to put tape over the camera.

"The U.S. Secret Service works closely with our partners in the business community to carry out our protective and investigative missions," USSS spokeswoman Melissa McKenzie said in a statement.

McKenzie said the Secret Service has been in contact with Powers since the July 27 incident.

"We hold these relationships in the highest regard and our personnel would not enter, or instruct our partners to enter, a business without the owner's permission," McKenzie said, stopping short of saying who was responsible.

Powers told Business Insider that "several people" who were "in and out for about an hour-and-a-half – just using my bathroom, the alarms going off, using my counter, with no permission."

"And then when they were done using the bathroom for two hours, they left, and left my building completely unlocked, and did not take the tape off the camera," she added.

Powers later said that a USSS representative contacted her after Business Insider sought comment from the agency for comment on the incident.

Fox News Digital has reached out to Powers for a response to the Secret Service's latest comment.

The incident comes less than a month after the assassination attempt on former President Trump during a rally in Butler, Pennsylvania.

The shooting put heavy scrutiny on the Secret Service, which was ultimately responsible for coordinating security with local law enforcement.

The scrutiny only intensified after it was revealed that law enforcement officers had observed the shooter, 20-year-old Thomas Matthew Crooks, and identified him as suspicious more than an hour before the shooting, but lost track of him.

Crooks was able to scale the roof of a building owned by AGR International Inc., a supplier of automation equipment for the glass and plastic packaging industry, and fire an estimated eight shots with an AR-15 style rifle.

After mounting pressure, Secret Service Director Kimberly Cheatle resigned, following heated testimony before the House Oversight Committee.

[MA] Secret Service apologizes for Pittsfield salon takeover (Boston Herald)

The Secret Service broke into the Four One Three Salon in Pittsfield, used the restroom, taped over the security camera and left the door unlocked during Kamala Harris's visit in late July, the salon owner told reporters.

Salon owner Alicia Powers told the Berkshire Eagle she would have "set up coffee and doughnuts for them" if the Secret Service had asked permission, but no one contacted her or her landlord about the entrance.

Harris visited Pittsfield on July 27 for her first fundraising event since she became the presumed Democratic nominee for president. She was expected to raise about \$1.4 million at an event at the town's the Colonial Theatre. The local salon is located across from Colonial Theatre.

Powers told reporters the Secret Service agents appeared to tape over a Ring security camera on the property, broke in, used the bathroom without cleaning up after themselves and left the door unlocked on their way out. They even ate a few mints on the counter, she said.

Around 8 a.m. on July 27, Powers said, she got an alert from her security camera on the business's back porch and could see a woman tape over the camera. She was on a previously scheduled vacation to Cape Cod at the time.

At 11:15 a.m., she told reporters, alarms began to go off and continued through about 12:40 p.m. Others cameras on the property showed people entering and exiting for two hours, Powers said. She drove home and reached the salon after crowds dissipated around 4 p.m.

Powers said she then notified Pittsfield Police, who directed her to Secret Service representatives.

Secret Service's Boston office reached out to Powers to confirm that the agency entered the property, iBerkshire reported via a spokesperson for the agency.

"We hold these relationships in the highest regard and our personnel would not enter, or instruct our partners to enter, a business without the owner's permission," the spokesperson said according to iBerkshire.

Powers said the Boston office apologized on behalf of the agency and offered to pay for any damages, cleaning or the business's private alarm bill, which went off throughout the incident.

The business owner told the Berkshire Eagle she was "happy with the apology" and it brought some "accountability."

However, she added, the way the agency posed a real threat to her business and livelihood.

"When they cleaned up and they left the tape on my camera and they left my back door

completely unlocked,” Powers told the Berkshire Eagle. “What could have happened in that hour and a half or two hours that you guys left the building unlocked?”

[MA] Kamala Harris’ Secret Service Covers Up Security Cameras At Private Business, Breaks Into Building: Report (Daily Wire)

Vice President Kamala Harris’ Secret Service detail was caught on video committing crimes against a local business owner during a Harris campaign event late last month in Massachusetts, according to a report.

Alicia Powers, owner of Four One Three Salon in Pittsfield, said that she would have been more than happy to let the Secret Service use her business as a comfort station during Harris’ event in the city on Saturday July 27 if they had simply asked her permission.

“I’m the kind of person that would have set up coffee and doughnuts for them had they asked me for permission,” said Powers.

“Instead, they taped over a security camera on the back porch, broke into the salon, helped themselves to the bathroom, ate the mints on the counter and left without tidying up the bathroom or locking the back door on the way out,” according to The Berkshire Eagle, a local newspaper.

The Secret Service agents never contacted her or her landlord to ask permission to enter the building.

Powers had decided to close her business for the remainder of the day on the 27th because the agents were doing intense bomb sweeps in the area and things became “a little bit chaotic.”

The Pittsfield Police Department has been supportive of her efforts to get accountability after what Harris’ agents did.

The Secret Service claims that they never would have entered the business if they were not given permission. Powers said that she did not give them permission and she feels violated, angry, and disrespected, the report said.

“When they cleaned up and they left the tape on my camera and they left my back door completely unlocked,” she said. “What could have happened in that hour and a half or two hours that you guys left the building unlocked?”

Brian Smith, the building’s landlord, told Business Insider that he did not give the Secret Service permission to enter.

“Me and my dad own the building, and I have a crazy eccentric guy that lives upstairs,” Smith told BI. “And he didn’t tell the Secret Service they could use it, and I didn’t tell them, and my father didn’t tell them, and they had no permission to go in there whatsoever.”

Powers had other cameras set up that alerted her that people were coming in and out of her

business for two hours.

“From the communication I’ve heard from the EMS workers, somebody dressed in all black was telling them to come in and use the bathroom all afternoon,” she said.

When she spoke to the New York Secret Service office, she said that they denied their agents would act that way and then tried to guilt her into letting go of the issue.

“And he kind of ended the conversation with telling me, ‘Do you think we need to deal with this right now with what we have going on?’ And my response was, ‘Sir, I’m not trying to be rude but I don’t deserve to deal with this right now either,’” she said.

Powers told Business Insider that the head of the Secret Service’s Boston-based field office called her and apologized after Business Insider published its report.

“He said to me everything that was done was done very wrong,” Powers said. “They were not supposed to tape my camera without permission. They were not supposed to enter the building without permission.”

The build-out of the security perimeter is set to begin as the workweek gets underway, according to the Secret Service.

The Chicago Office-Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC) also confirmed to WGN-TV that there will be intermittent traffic impacts and even some rolling street closures to begin the construction starting on Monday.

The security perimeter includes two zones, a red one that’s for credentialed personnel only, and a yellow one that is open to the public, but subject to security checks.

Starting Friday, there will be additional closures for pedestrians and vehicles, but authorities said they have been trying to keep folks as informed as possible, particularly those living and working within the vicinity of the United Center and McCormick Place.

While Milwaukee’s significantly smaller police force had to be bolstered by officers from as far away as Miami for the Republican National Convention, Chicago will be supplemented by other law enforcement from around the state and federal agents.

On Tuesday, new details about where demonstrations can be held are expected to be released by a federal judge.

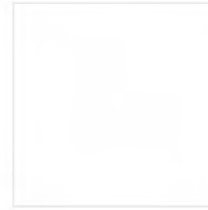

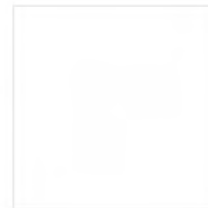

[MA] Secret Service busted into a salon to let people use the bathroom during a Kamala Harris fundraiser, business owner says (Business Insider)

It was worse than a bad hair day.

Secret Service agents taped over a security camera and broke into a Massachusetts hair salon while securing the area for a Kamala Harris campaign event, according to the salon's owner.

The intrusion happened on July 27, ahead of Vice President Harris's first in-person fundraiser since becoming the presumptive Democratic nominee.

The owner of the Four One Three Salon, Alicia Powers, told Business Insider that she closed her Pittsfield, Massachusetts, business that day at the request of the Secret Service, which examined the area earlier in the week. The salon is located behind the Colonial Theatre, a performing arts space in the Berkshires, where Harris spoke.

"They had a bunch of people in and out of here doing a couple of bomb sweeps again — totally understand what they have to do, due to the nature of the situation," Powers told Business Insider. "And at that point, my team felt like it was a little bit chaotic, and we just made the decision to close for Saturday."

A Secret Service spokesperson told Business Insider that the agency's employees "would not enter" without the permission of the business owner, but acknowledged an agent taped over the security camera lens.

At 8:10 that Saturday morning, a Secret Service agent — wearing a dark suit and open-collared white shirt, but no pin on her lapel — walked up to the salon's front entrance while swinging a roll of masking tape in her left hand. She looked at the door. Then she looked at the security camera on the porch. Then she looked at the door again.

She walked away. When she returned two minutes later, she grabbed a chair from the porch, stood on it, and taped over the Ring security camera that had been watching her.

(Business Insider blurred the face of a Secret Service agent in the video below.)

The door was locked. But later that afternoon, another security camera, pointing at the door from the inside of the building, spotted four other people over the course of nearly two hours.

Two people wearing emergency medical services uniforms and one person in a camouflage law enforcement uniform walked in. The fourth person, wearing a dark suit and white shirt like a Secret Service officer, stood by the door.

The salon's security alarm rang the whole time. The security footage from the two cameras, which Powers shared with BI, doesn't show anyone allowing the people in.

"There were several people in and out for about an hour-and-a-half — just using my bathroom, the alarms going off, using my counter, with no permission," Powers said.

"And then when they were done using the bathroom for two hours, they left, and left my building completely unlocked, and did not take the tape off the camera," she continued.

Powers told BI that an EMS worker later told her the Secret Service agent in charge of security that day "was telling people to come in and use the bathroom."

BI asked Secret Service spokesperson Melissa McKenzie whether the agency invited other people to use the bathroom. She told BI that agency employees "would not" tell someone to enter the salon without the owner's permission.

When Powers returned to the property later that day, she found the door's lock looked like it had been picked, she told BI.

The people who entered the Four One Three Salon didn't do much damage aside from leaving an untidy bathroom behind, Powers said.

But what bothered her was what she saw as sheer disregard for her business, by entering without permission and leaving the place unlocked when they left, she said.

Powers said she felt "violated."

"Whoever was visiting, whether it was a celebrity or not, I probably would've opened the door and made them coffee and brought in donuts to make it a great afternoon for them," she told BI. "But they didn't even have the audacity to ask for permission. They just helped themselves."

Brian Smith, the building's landlord, said he didn't give the Secret Service permission to use the property either.

"Me and my dad own the building, and I have a crazy eccentric guy that lives upstairs," Smith told BI. "And he didn't tell the Secret Service they could use it, and I didn't tell them, and my father didn't tell them, and they had no permission to go in there whatsoever."

The Secret Service apologized after BI reached out. The day after BI initially reached out to the Secret Service for comment for this story — more than a week after it entered the business — an agency spokesperson said it had "since communicated" with Powers.

"The U.S. Secret Service works closely with our partners in the business community to carry out our protective and investigative missions," McKenzie wrote in an email to BI. "The

Secret Service has since communicated with the affected business owner."

"We hold these relationships in the highest regard and our personnel would not enter, or instruct our partners to enter, a business without the owner's permission," she added.

Bill Pickle, a former Secret Service special agent, who previously oversaw training for the agency, told Business Insider that it's conceivable why a member of the Secret Service would tape over the security camera lens.

Pickle speculated that someone from the agency's technical services division — which handles explosives, bugging, wiring, and other physical security risks — may have wanted to limit visibility of Harris's whereabouts if the vice president were to walk into the camera's view.

But invading the property to use the bathroom "sounds weird," Pickle told BI.

"We just don't go in and take place or seize it," Pickle said. "The only time you do that is if it's a crime scene or if there's a real threat."

Powers said she contacted a local Secret Service field office after the incident, and that a person there told her to ask the local police, who said they knew nothing about it.

"I know for certain none of our members were involved in this," Pittsfield Police Captain Matthew Hill told BI.

On Thursday morning — the day after BI reached out to the agency for comment — the head of the Secret Service's Boston-based field office called Powers to apologize, she said.

"He said to me everything that was done was done very wrong," Powers said. "They were not supposed to tape my camera without permission. They were not supposed to enter the building without permission."

Powers said the Secret Service representative she spoke to offered to have the salon cleaned and pay her alarm company bill for the day. Powers said he also offered to visit and apologize in person over a cup of coffee.

Powers said she'd take him up on it.

"I want him to see the salon, and I want him to see what I do for the community, and be in this space, and have an understanding as to how this could have been ruined with the slightest wrong move," she said.

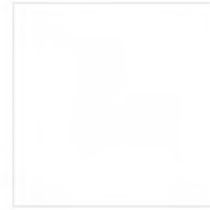

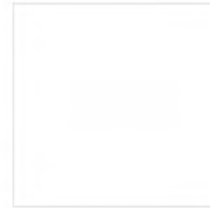

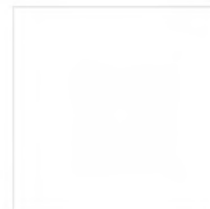

Hi, I hope you're well. My name is Jacob Shamsian and I'm a journalist at Business Insider.

I'm writing a story regarding Secret Service activity during a recent visit from Vice President Kamala Harris in Pittsfield, Massachusetts.

I spoke to (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) the owner of the Four One Three Salon in Pittsfield. She told me that on the day of Harris's visit, on July 27, she closed down her salon, which is located just behind the Colonial Theatre where Harris held a fundraiser.

She said that a Secret Service agent taped over the exterior security camera of her salon. And then a couple of hours later, her lock was picked and several people — including one person wearing a Secret Service uniform — entered the salon to use the bathroom. They left the door unlocked when they left.

Security footage that (b)(6) shared with me backs up her version of events.

Powers told me that she later spoke to an EMT, who told her that the "person in charge" of the Secret Service that day told people to use her bathroom's salon. She said she spoke to someone at a Secret Service field office (it wasn't clear to me if it was the Massachusetts or New York field office — Pittsfield is in Massachusetts just across the border from New York), who blamed the local police.

My questions are:

- Did a Secret Service officer pick the lock of the Four One Three Salon in Pittsfield on July 27? No one from the USSS picked the lock of the Salon door.
- Why did an officer tape over the exterior security camera? Our CSP Advance SA placed a piece of plastic over the camera because it viewed our arrival/departure area. She did not contact the Salon about the camera because the arrival/departure switched from initial walk throughs from one side of the building to the rear of the building. The camera was discovered the day of the visit and a piece of plastic was taped over the camera to block the view of our arrival. When she went to remove the plastic off the camera it had already been removed.
- Did the Secret Service seek permission from (b)(6) or the property owner to use the facility for the bathroom or any other reason? If not, why not? USSS personnel did not ask for permission to enter the Salon nor did any of our personnel enter the business. We reviewed the videos provided to us and observed that none of the individuals who entered the Salon were USSS personnel. The Pittsfield Police Chief confirmed those individuals were state or local police, fire, or EMS.
- Did the Secret Service agent in charge — or any other officer — tell others to use (b)(6) bathroom? No one from the USSS directed any state or local personnel to enter the Salon or use their restrooms.
- Why not lock the door after leaving? Or inform (b)(6) or the landlord? No one from the USSS was aware that state and local employees associated with the visit entered the Salon until days after the visit.

If you can get back to me by some point tomorrow morning, I'd appreciate it.

Hi, I hope you're well. My name is Jacob Shamsian and I'm a journalist at Business Insider.

I'm writing a story regarding Secret Service activity during a recent visit from Vice President Kamala Harris in Pittsfield, Massachusetts.

I spoke to [REDACTED] the owner of the Four One Three Salon in Pittsfield. She told me that on the day of Harris's visit, on July 27, she closed down her salon, which is located just behind the Colonial Theatre where Harris held a fundraiser.

She said that a Secret Service agent taped over the exterior security camera of her salon. And then a couple of hours later, her lock was picked and several people — including one person wearing a Secret Service uniform — entered the salon to use the bathroom. They left the door unlocked when they left.

Security footage that [REDACTED] shared with me backs up her version of events.

[REDACTED] told me that she later spoke to an EMT, who told her that the "person in charge" of the Secret Service that day told people to use her bathroom's salon. She said she spoke to someone at a Secret Service field office (it wasn't clear to me if it was the Massachusetts or New York field office — Pittsfield is in Massachusetts just across the border from New York), who blamed the local police.

My questions are:

- Did a Secret Service officer pick the lock of the Four One Three Salon in Pittsfield on July 27?
- Why did an officer tape over the exterior security camera?
- Did the Secret Service seek permission from (b)(6) or the property owner to use the facility for the bathroom or any other reason? If not, why not?
- Did the Secret Service agent in charge — or any other officer — tell others to use (b)(6) bathroom?
- Why not lock the door after leaving? Or inform (b)(6) or the landlord?

If you can get back to me by some point tomorrow morning, I'd appreciate it.

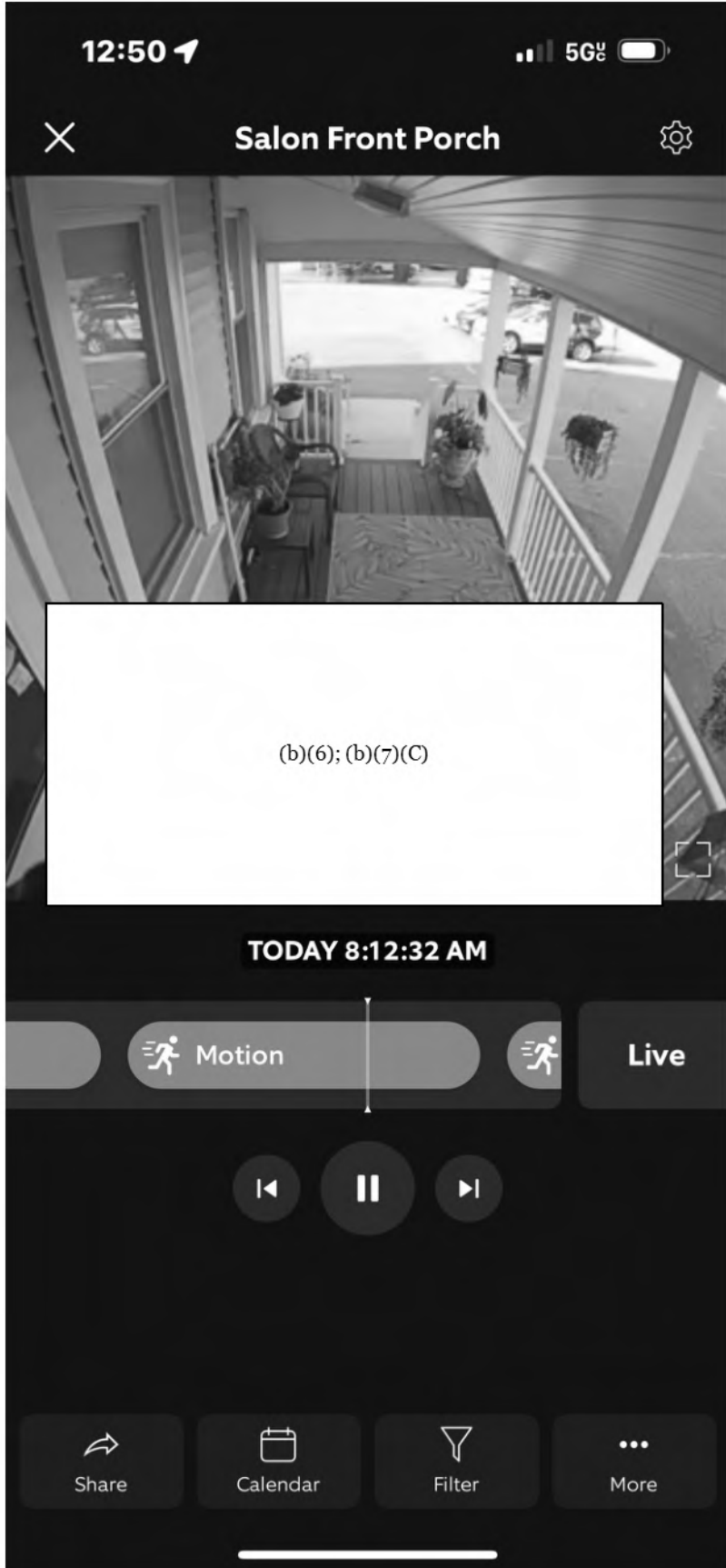
