I'm adding Facebook to this ticket, and recommending that they take action on this page.

We believe that this page was automatically generated after someone running for Mayor in Hood River County repeatedly tagged themselves at the "Hood River County Elections Office". This person uses two Facebook accounts with different names (b)(6), which is why two people have checked into this location. Their repeated check-ins triggered the creation of this page, which now exclusively features their location-tagged posts with their commentary about local politics.

Our understanding is that another verified page, such as the Hood River County page, could claim or request deletion for this page. However, we recommend that Facebook take immediate action on this page (and similar unofficial pages for election-related organizations), due to its potential for spreading misinformation about voting processes in Hood River County.
